

Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Medicine (Ophthalmology)

Below are the **minimum requirements**. Candidate must:

- Basic Medical Degree recognised by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC)
- Qualifications for registration as a medical practitioner under the Malaysian Medical Act 1971 (Act 50)
- A pass in the Malaysian Pre-Entrance Examination (MedEx) in Ophthalmology
- Passed MedEx (Ophthalmology) within 5 years from the semester intake

Selection criteria include:

- Passed Multi-Mini Interview conducted by Malaysian Universities Conjoint Committee of Ophthalmology. This includes;
 - a) General Conduct
 - b) Communication Skills
 - c) Critical and Ethical Thinking
 - d) Professionalism
 - e) Language Proficiency
 - f) Interest in Ophthalmology
- Good academic performance in the exit examination of undergraduate program (MD/MBBS)
- Good grade in MedEx
- Good recommendation from two referees
- Experience in poster presentation and journal publication
- Comprehensive ocular assessment:
 - a) Best corrected visual acuity 6/9 or better
 - b) Normal orthoptic findings
 - c) Stereopsis of at least 55 second of arc
 - d) Colour test (exclude severe protan)
