

Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Radiology Programme

Below are the minimum requirements. Candidates must:

1. possess a medical degree (MD, MBBS, MBBCh or equivalent medical qualification)
2. be registered for medical practice by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) under the Medical (Amendment) Act 2012 and Medical Regulations 2017.
Non-Malaysian candidates must obtain a Temporary Practising Certificate from MMC.
3. fulfill the criteria's set by the sponsoring body eg Ministry of Health, Ministry of Education.
4. achieve acceptable level of English proficiency as defined by each university
5. pass the Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEx) with a minimum grade determined by the Conjoint Board of Radiology.
6. pass the entrance assessment conducted by the Conjoint Board of Radiology.
The assessment consists of OSCE or film viewing and plain film reporting
7. pass the interview process by the Conjoint Board of Radiology.
