

Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Medicine in Transfusion Medicine programme

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Candidates **MUST** possess a medical degree such as MBBS, MD, MBChB, or other equivalent qualifications recognized by the University Senate and registered with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).

 - Candidates holding degrees from institutions not recognized by the MMC must sit for and pass the Examination for Provisional Registration (EPR) prior to admission. For further details, refer to:

2. Candidates **MUST** have a minimum of two (2) years of clinical experience after graduation, obtained in hospitals or healthcare institutions certified and accepted by the University Senate.
3. All candidates are required to pass the Medical Specialist Pre-Entrance Examination (MedEx) and attend an interview as part of the final selection process.
4. Non-Malaysian candidates **MUST** obtain a Temporary Practicing Certificate from MMC. In addition, they must undergo at least six (6) months of clinical and laboratory attachments and assessments in the relevant department prior to admission.
5. Candidates **MUST** also be in good physical and mental condition.
