## Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Nuclear Medicine Programme

Below are the minimum requirements. Candidates must:

- 1. possess a medical degree (MD, MBBS, MBBCh or equivalent medical qualification)
- 2. be registered for medical practice by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) under the Medical (Amendment) Act 2012 and Medical Regulations 2017. International applicants must obtain a Temporary Practicing Certificate from MMC and are required to complete 3 to 6 months of clinical attachment in Malaysia prior to enrolment.
- 3. fulfill the criteria set by their sponsoring body e.g., Ministry of Health, universities, private institutions etc.
- 4. fulfil the minimum English language requirement (MUET / IELTS / TOEFL / OET) as defined by the university.
- 5. have at least 2 years' clinical experience as a fully registered medical officer working in medical facility. Clinical posting in Nuclear Medicine or Radiology is an added advantage.
- 6. pass the Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEx) with a minimum grade determined by the Specialty Board.
- 7. pass the interview process conducted by the Specialty Board.
